When Mes Bach Ltd officially opened its doors on 1st September 2025 in Cross Hands, Carmarthenshire, it marked the culmination of months of hard work, careful planning and dedicated support. The new Welsh language wraparound, after-school and holiday club has quickly become a nurturing and inspiring environment for children, with a strong emphasis on outdoor play and exploration.



Behind this success story is not only the vision and determination of Natasha Coleman, the club's founder, but also the tailored support she received from Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs and the CYMell project.

From the very beginning of Natasha's journey, she worked closely with her local Welsh Language Childcare Business Development Officer from Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs. This support was crucial in navigating the many steps involved in establishing a new childcare business. Natasha was guided through the development of policies and procedures, ensuring Mes Bach could provide safe, high-quality, and sustainable childcare provision.

She also accessed relevant Playwork training, equipping her with the knowledge and confidence to embed play at the heart of her new setting. This training reinforced Natasha's passion for creating a space that was not only practical for families but also child-centred, welcoming and nurturing.

A significant milestone in Natasha's journey was her engagement with the CYMell project, through which she successfully accessed the CYMell New Places Grant.

With the help of this funding, Natasha was able to bring her vision for Mes Bach Ltd to life, establishing a setting that now offers both families and children in Cross Hands an invaluable provision.

The impact of this support has been profound. Families now have access to flexible childcare that meets their needs, while children benefit from a rich variety of opportunities to play, discover and grow in a safe, supportive environment.

The collaboration between Natasha and Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs demonstrates the power of partnership working in strengthening childcare provision across Wales. Natasha's commitment, combined with professional guidance and financial support, has ensured that Mes Bach launched as a high-quality, sustainable setting with children's play and well-being at its core.

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Wedi'i Ariannu ar gyfer y Dyfodol: Sut Helpodd y Grant Lleoliadau Newydd, gan CYMell i lansio Mes Bach Ltd

Pan agorodd Mes Bach Ltd ei ddrysau'n swyddogol ar 1^{af} Medi 2025 yn Cross Hands, Caerfyrddin, nododd hynny'r ddiwedd ar fisoedd o waith caled, cynllunio gofalus a chymorth ymroddedig. Mae'r clybiau Cymraeg newydd, sef clwb cofleidiol, clwb 'rôl ysgol a chlybiau gwyliau wedi dod yn amgylcheddau magwraeth ac ysbrydoledig yn gyflym i blant, gan roi pwyslais cryf ar archwilio a chwarae yn yr awyr agored.



Nid gweledigaeth a phenderfyniad Natasha Coleman, sylfaenydd y clwb, yn unig sydd y tu ôl i'r stori lwyddiant hon, mae'r cyngor personol a gafwyd gan Glybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs a phrosiect CYMell wedi bod yn elfen hefyd. O ddechrau taith Natasha, bu hi'n gweithio'n agos gyda'i Swyddog Datblygu Busnes Gofal Plant Iaith Gymraeg Lleol o Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs. Roedd y gefnogaeth hon yn hanfodol wrth lywio'r nifer o gamau sy'n gysylltiedig â sefydlu busnes gofal plant newydd. Cafodd Natasha ei harwain wrth iddi ddatblygu polisiau a gweithdrefnau, gan sicrhau y gallai Mes Bach ddarparu darpariaeth gofal plant diogel, o ansawdd uchel a chynaliadwy.

Atgyfnerthodd yr hyfforddiant hwn angerdd Natasha dros greu lle a oedd, nid yn unig yn ymarferol i deuluoedd ond hefyd yn canolbwyntio ar y plentyn, yn groesawgar ac yn feithringar.

Carreg filltir arwyddocaol yn nhaith Natasha oedd ei hymgysylltiad â phrosiect CYMell, a thrwy hynny llwyddodd i gael Grant CYMell Lleuedd Newydd.

Gyda chymorth y cyllid hwn, llwyddodd Natasha i wireddu ei gweledigaeth ar gyfer Mes Bach Ltd, gan sefydlu lleoliad sydd bellach yn cynnig darpariaeth amhrisiadwy i deuluoedd a phlant yn Cross Hands.

Mae effaith y gefnogaeth hon wedi bod yn ddofn. Mae gan deuluoedd bellach fynediad at ofal plant hyblyg sy'n diwallu eu hanghenion, tra bod plant yn elwa o amrywiaeth gyfoethog o gyfleoedd i chwarae, darganfod a thyfu mewn amgylchedd diogel a chefnogol.

Mae'r cydweithrediad rhwng Natasha a Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs yn dangos pŵer gweithio mewn partneriaeth wrth gryfhau darpariaeth gofal plant ledled Cymru.
