



Incidental Welsh Workshop: Denbighshire

Delivered through the CYMell project

Supported through Welsh Government funding, Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs delivered an Incidental Welsh Workshop in Denbighshire as part of the CYMell project—an important step in strengthening everyday Welsh language use across the Out of School Childcare sector.

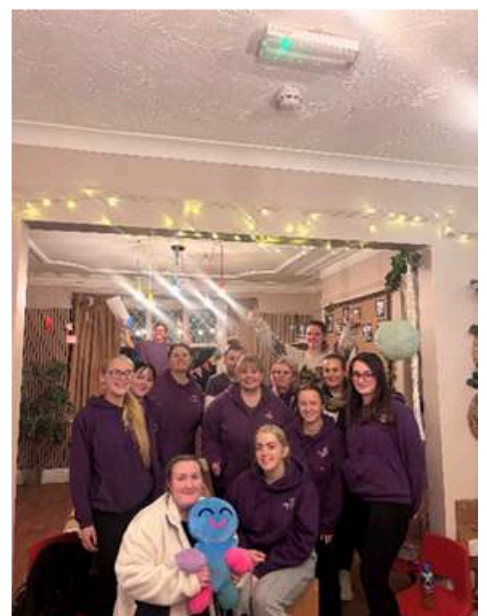
The workshop blended discussion, interactive games, and practical resources to create an engaging, hands-on learning environment. Practitioners had the opportunity to practise Welsh in real-life scenarios, share ideas, and build the confidence needed to integrate simple phrases naturally into their daily routines with children.

Staff responded extremely positively, describing the workshop as **fun, informative, and enjoyable**. Several team members even messaged afterwards to say how beneficial they found the session. The mix of **practical activities** and **insightful discussion** was highlighted as particularly effective.

The **lanyard flash cards** were especially well received, with staff excited to continue using them as a quick, accessible reference during everyday interactions.

The enjoyable, hands-on approach helped staff feel much more confident in using incidental Welsh throughout the day. They left the session motivated and well-prepared to introduce simple Welsh phrases during routines, transitions, and play.

The Incidental Welsh Workshop successfully strengthened staff confidence, expanded their practical Welsh language skills, and provided engaging tools that can be used in everyday practice. As part of the wider CYMell project, this workshop marks meaningful progress in embedding natural, day-to-day Welsh across Out of School Childcare settings.





Gweithdy Cymraeg Achlysurol: Dinbych

A darparwyd drwy'r prosiect CYMell

Gyda chefnogaeth gan Gyllid Llywodraeth Cymru, aeth Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs ati i gynllunio a darparu gweithdy Cymraeg Achlysurol yn Ninbych fel rhan o'r prosiect CYMell—sef cam pwysig i gryfhau defnydd yr iaith Cymraeg beunyddiol ar hyd a lled y sector Gofal Plant All-Ysgol.

Roedd y gweithdy yn cynnwys cymysgedd o sgysiau, gemau rhyngweithiol, ac adnoddau ymarferol i greu amgylchedd dysgu ymarferol ac ymgysylltiol. Cafodd ymarferydd y cyfle i ymarfer Cymraeg mewn senarios bywyd go iawn, rhannu syniadau, a magu'r hyder sydd angen er mwyn integreiddio ymadroddion syml yn naturiol i'w harferion beunyddiol gyda phlant.

Ymatebwyd staff yn gadarnhaol iawn, gan ddisgrifio'r gweithdy yn **hwyllog, addysgiadol ac yn bleserus**. Anfonodd sawl aelod o staff neges wedyn i ddweud pa mor fuddiol gwelsant nhw'r sesiwn. Uchaf bwyntiodd y cymysgedd o **weithgareddau ymarferol a thrafodaeth graff** fel rhywbeth oedd yn enwedig o effeithiol.

Cafodd y **cerdyn fflach laniad** ei groesawu'n fawr, gyda staff yn edrych ymlaen at ddefnyddio nhw fel cyfeirnod hygyrch yn ystod rhyngweithiadau beunyddiol.

Roedd y dull pleserus, ymarferol yn helpu staff teimlo'n fwy hyderus i ddefnyddio Cymraeg achlysurol trwy gydol y diwrnod. Gadawsant y sesiwn yn teimlo'n llawer mwy parod a chymell i gyflwyno idiomau Cymraeg syml yn ystod arferion, trawsnewidiadau a chwarae.

Llwyddodd y Gweithdy Cymraeg Achlysurol i gryfhau hyder staff, ehangu eu sgiliau iaith Gymraeg ymarferol, a darparu offer deniadol y gellir eu defnyddio mewn ymarfer bob dydd.
