Kidz Den, a community run Charitable Incorporated Organisation, has successfully been delivering Out of School Childcare for many years in Merthyr Tydfil, South East Wales.

Through the National Lottery 'Connected Childcare Communities' project, the Childcare Business Development Officer (CBDO) provided one to one support for the Playleader to complete a financial forecast and assist with a Local Authority Capital Grant Funding application.

The financial forecast was completed to provide a clear picture of current finances and a plan to estimate future income and expenditure of the business for the next 3 years. This process helped the club to:

- Identify potential overspending and cost control
- Evidence need for the Local Authority Capital Grant application
- Ensure the new rental agreement was affordable
- Improve strategic planning and establish robust financial systems
- Predict and avoid any future potential financial shortfalls

Both the Out of School Childcare Club – along with the local Cylch Meithrin – had recently moved to a shared location, within the same local community. The successful grant application has enabled the Club to upgrade the children's toilets in the new venue. The shared location has also supported ongoing sustainability as the convenience of co-located childcare across the age range is more convenient for families and numbers have increased.

Kelly stated that "Clare has been a massive help with the grants, we couldn't have done it without her. The toilets are so much cleaner and age appropriate for the children, we have had so many more families joining us since we moved to our own building".
