



Canolfan Beaumaris, Anglesey: CYMell Project Impact

Delivered through the CYMell project

Canolfan Beaumaris wanted to create an affordable, bilingual holiday club to meet local childcare demand. With support from Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs (CPCCKC) through the CYMell project, the team moved from early planning to successful Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW) registration and opened in July 2026.

The project's impact is clear: a new registered bilingual holiday club now offers places for up to 36 children, giving families reliable childcare and children safe, and giving creative and enriching holiday experiences.

CPCCKC's support included practical guidance, encouragement, registration advice, training signposting and a £1,000 CYMell grant to strengthen the club's readiness and sustainability.

Why registration mattered

Founder Nora Kirk recognised the pressure on working families during school holidays and wanted to offer childcare that was affordable, accessible and full of positive play experiences.

"I have tried to put holiday fun into holiday time and give parents guilt-free time to work, knowing their children are having a great time."

This investment gave the team the skills, confidence and capacity to deliver safe, inclusive, high-quality play for local children.

Support that made the difference

Canolfan Beaumaris described CPCCKC's support as vital throughout the process, helping turn a complex registration journey into a clear, achievable plan.

"Everything – she was always at the end of the phone. We couldn't have done it without Elliw."

Impact for children, families and the community

The club is already creating meaningful impact: children are developing new skills through play, families have access to trusted holiday childcare, and the community has gained a sustainable bilingual service.

"Children have seen and used skills they have never used before. They are developing every day."

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Canolfan Beaumaris, Ynys Môn: Effaith Prosiect CYMell

Cyflawnwyd drwy'r prosiect CYMell

Roedd Canolfan Beaumaris yn dymuno creu clwb gwyliau fforddiadwy a dwyieithog i ddiwallu'r galw lleol am ofal plant. Gyda chefnogaeth gan Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs (CPCCK) trwy'r prosiect CYMell, symudodd y tîm o gynllunio cynnar i gofrestru'n llwyddiannus gydag Arolygiaeth Gofal Cymru (AGC), ac aethant ati i agor ym mis Gorffennaf 2026.

Mae effaith y prosiect yn glir: mae clwb gwyliau dwyieithog sydd wedi cofrestru'n ddiweddar bellach yn cynnig lleoedd ar gyfer 36 o blant, gan roi gofal plant dibynadwy i deuluoedd a phrofiadau gwyliau diogel, creadigol a chyfoethog i blant.

Roedd cefnogaeth CPCCK yn cynnwys arweiniad ymarferol, anogaeth, cyngor ar gofrestru, arwyddbostio at hyfforddiant a grant CYMell o £1,000 i gryfhau parodrwydd a chynaliadwyedd y clwb.

Pam roedd cofrestru'n bwysig

Roedd y sefydlydd Nora Kirk yn adnabod y pwysau ar deuluoedd sy'n gweithio yn ystod gwyliau'r ysgol, ac roedd yn dymuno cynnig gofal plant a oedd yn fforddiadwy, yn hygyrch ac yn llawn profiadau chwarae cadarnhaol.

"Rwyf wedi ceisio rhoi hwyl gwyliau i amser gwyliau a rhoi amser di-euog i rieni weithio, gan wybod bod eu plant yn cael amser gwyh."

Rhoddodd y buddsoddiad hwn y sgiliau, yr hyder a'r capasiti i'r tîm gyflwyno chwarae diogel, cynhwysol ac o ansawdd uchel i blant lleol.

Cefnogaeth a wnaeth gwahaniaeth

Disgrifiodd Canolfan Beaumaris gefnogaeth CPCCK fel rhywbeth hollbwysig trwy gydol y broses, gan helpu i droi taith gofrestru gymhleth i gynllun clir a chyraeddadwy.

"Wnaethon nhw helpu gyda phopeth — roedd hi bob amser ar ben arall y ffôn. Ni fyddem wedi gallu ei wneud heb Elliw."

Effaith ar blant, teuluoedd a'r gymuned

Mae'r clwb eisoes yn creu effaith ystyrlon: mae plant yn datblygu sgiliau newydd trwy chwarae, mae gan deuluoedd fynediad at ofal plant dibynadwy, ac mae'r gymuned wedi ennill gwasanaeth dwyieithog cynaliadwy.

"Mae plant wedi gweld a defnyddio sgiliau nad oeddent erioed wedi'u defnyddio o'r blaen. Maent yn datblygu bob dydd."



Sylfaen gref ar gyfer y dyfodol

Mae taith Canolfan Beaumaris yn dangos sut y gall cyllid wedi'i dargedu, arweiniad arbenigol a hyfforddiant ymarferol helpu darparwyr cymunedol i greu atebion gofal plant sy'n para. Trwy CYMell a chefnogaeth CPCKC, mae'r clwb wedi adeiladu sylfaen gref ar gyfer twf yn y dyfodol.
