



Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni, Gwynedd

Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni, Gwynedd: Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni, supported by Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs' CYMell Project, has expanded its service to include an Afterschool Childcare Club for children up to the age of 12 after successfully being awarded the tender to provide full day care on the site of Ysgol Llanllyfni.

Summary

Based at Ysgol Llanllyfni, Gwynedd, Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni supports the education and growth of children aged two to school age. Gwynedd County Council invited local childcare providers to tender to provide full day care on the school site answering parent's need. The Cylch applied and were successful in bid to deliver care for children aged 2 to 12. After receiving fully funded Playwork training, financial assistance through the CIW (expansion) grant and specialist business support from Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs Welsh Language Development Officers funded through the CYMell Project the Cylch opened their Afterschool Club, as an extension of the Cylch, which offered the advantage of being on school grounds, so children can go straight to the club without having to travel.

CYMell Funding and Support

Through the CYMell project, funded by the Welsh Government, Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni has been supported by Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs Welsh Language Development Officer, Eiliw Price, through specialist support as they work through the CIW registration process.

"Eiliw has been great and is always available to support, I believe everyone should be members of Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs there is so much help available."

Financial assistance was also provided through the CIW registration grant to support them with the costs associated with the expansion. Saran Haf Japheth leader of Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni noted that the grant was a great support to them during the expansion process; "the grant has helped us to be able to have the resources to create an inclusive area".

Fully Funded Playwork Training

To enhance the quality of their provision, meet the National Minimum Standards and fulfil the registration requirements of Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW) Staff of Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni accessed the fully funded Level 3 Transition to Playwork through Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs.

"The training has helped so much, as After School Club provision is something completely new to us, the age we are used to is ages 2-3. The course has helped us to know what activities the children like and about the play cues. We now feel that we provide the children with the best experiences."



Impact

Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni expanded their provision and opened an Afterschool Childcare Club in October 2024. The establishment of a new Afterschool Club has provided a vital resource to families, supporting working parent and fostering a sense of community, offering a safe enriching environment for children to play. Staff have risen to this new challenge and have truly put their Playwork training in to practice by ensuring the children are central in everything that they do.

“We have been following the children's voice to create activities, playing outside, rounders, toasting marshmallows, doing an "obstacle course and sand and water activities. The club has been great, it's been an exciting time for all of us as it's something completely new. Having the club helps the parents to be able to go out and work normal hours / work longer.”

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Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni, Gwynedd: Mae Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni, a chefnogwyd gan Brosiect CYMell Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs, wedi ehangu ei wasanaeth i ddarparu clwb gofal plant ar ôl ysgol i blant hyd at 12 oed ar ôl llwyddo i ennill y tendr i ddarparu gofal dydd llawn ar safle Ysgol Llanllyfni.

Crynodeb

Wedi'i leoli yn Ysgol Llanllyfni, Gwynedd, mae Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni yn cefnogi addysg a datblygiad plant o oedran dau i oedran ysgol. Roedd Cyngor Sir Gwynedd wedi gwahodd darparwyr gofal plant lleol i roi cais tendr er mwyn ddarparu gofal drwy'r dydd ar y safle ysgol er mwyn ddiwallu anghenion rhieni. Gwnaeth y Cylch gais ac enillodd y tendr i ddarparu gofal i blant rhwng 2 i 12 oed. Agorodd y Cylch eu Clwb Ar ôl Ysgol fel estyniad o'r Cylch ar ôl derbyn hyfforddiant Chwarae Gweithwyr Chwarae wedi'i ariannu'n llawn, cymorth ariannol drwy grant AGC (ehangu) a chymorth busnes arbenigol gan Swyddogion Datblygu Iaith Gymraeg Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs, a ariennir drwy Brosiect CYMell. Roedd manteision y Clwb Ar ôl Ysgol yn cynnwys bod ar dir yr ysgol, felly y gallai'r plant fynd yn syth i'r clwb heb orfod teithio.

Cyllid a Chefnogaeth gan CYMell

Drwy Brosiect CYMell, a ariannwyd gan Lywodraeth Cymru, mae Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni wedi cael cefnogaeth gan Swyddog Datblygu Busnesau Gofal Plant Cymraeg Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs, Eiliw Price, drwy gymorth arbenigol wrth iddynt weithio drwy'r broses cofrestru AGC.

"Mae Eiliw wedi bod yn wych ac mae hi bob amser ar gael i ddarparu cefnogaeth, rwy'n credu y dylai pawb fod yn aelodau o Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs, mae cymaint o help ar gael."

Darparwyd cymorth ariannol hefyd drwy grant cofrestru AGC i'w helpu gyda'r costau sy'n gysylltiedig â'r ehangu. Nododd Saran Haf Japheth, arweinydd Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni, fod y grant wedi bod yn gefnogaeth fawr iddynt yn ystod y broses ehangu; "Mae'r grant wedi ein helpu i allu cael yr adnoddau i greu maes cynhwysol."

Hyfforddiant Gwaith Chwarae wedi'i Ariannu'n Llawn

Er mwyn gwella ansawdd eu darpariaeth, cwrdd â'r Safonau Isaf Cenedlaethol a chydymffurfio â gofynion cofrestru Gofal Iechyd Cymru (AGC), defnyddiodd staff Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni'r hyfforddiant Gwaith Chwarae Lefel 3, sy'n cael ei ariannu'n llawn, drwy Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs.

"Mae'r hyfforddiant wedi helpu cymaint, gan fod darpariaeth Clwb Ar ôl Ysgol yn rhywbeth hollol newydd i ni, y grŵp oedran rydym ni'n gyfarwydd a yw 2-3 oed. Mae'r cwrs wedi ein helpu i wybod pa weithgareddau mae'r plant yn eu hoffi a phan fyddant yn rhoi arwyddion chwarae. Rydym bellach yn teimlo ein bod yn darparu'r profiadau gorau i'r plant."



Effaith

Agorodd Cylch Meithrin Llanllyfni eu darpariaeth ac agorodd Glwb Gofal Plant Ar ôl Ysgol ym mis Hydref 2024. Mae'r Clwb Ar ôl Ysgol newydd wedi rhoi adnodd hanfodol i deuluoedd, gan gefnogi rhieni sy'n gweithio a meithrin teimlad o gymuned, gan gynnig amgylchedd diogel a chyfoethogi i blant chwarae. Mae'r staff wedi ymateb i'r her newydd hon ac wedi rhoi eu hyfforddiant Chwarae Gweithwyr Chwarae ar waith drwy sicrhau bod y plant yn ganolog i bob peth maent yn ei wneud.

"Rydym wedi dilyn llais y plant i greu gweithgareddau, chwarae allan, rownders, rhostio malws meddal, gwneud cwrs rhwystrau a gweithgareddau tywod a dŵr. Mae'r clwb wedi bod yn wych, mae wedi bod yn amser cyffrous i ni i gyd gan ei fod yn rhywbeth hollol newydd. Mae cael y clwb yn helpu'r rhieni i allu mynd allan i weithio oriau arferol / gweithio'n hirach."
