

Ynglŷn â'r cynllun peilot

Cynigir gwasanaeth peilot yn ystod gwyliau ysgol yr haf i alluogi plant o oedran ysgol llawn amser gydag Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol (ADY) sy'n dod i'r amlwg neu sydd wedi'u nodi i fynychu gofal plant. Galluogi rhieni/gofalwyr i weithio, mynychu addysg neu gymryd rhan mewn hyfforddiant.

Mae'r grant yn helpu'r clwb i gyflogi Gweithiwr Chwarae ychwanegol i gefnogi'r plentyn.

Cymhwysra

Mae'r grant ar gyfer plant a phobl ifanc o oedran ysgol llawn amser sydd angen cymorth un-i-un i fynychu Clwb Gofal Gwyliau.

Efallai y rhoddir blaenoriaeth lle mae gofal plant yn cefnogi rhieni/gofalwyr i weithio, dychwelyd i'r gwaith neu hyfforddiant, derbyn gofal seibiant, neu alluogi'r plentyn i gael mynediad at gyfleoedd chwarae.

Gall anghenion cymorth gynnwys anghenion penodol, corfforol, emosiynol, cymdeithasol, ymddygiadol, dysgu, synhwyraidd, lleferydd, iaith neu gyfathrebu, cymorth lle mae'r Saesneg yn iaith ychwanegol, neu angen arall a nodwyd.

Pwy all wneud cais neu atgyfeirio?

Gwneir ceisiadau gan y Clwb Gofal Plant Gwyliau.

Gall ysgol, rhiant/gofalwr, sefydliad partner neu berson proffesiynol sy'n adnabod y plentyn ac sy'n cefnogi'r teulu wneud atgyfeiriad i'r ddarpariaeth. Mae angen cais ar wahân ar gyfer pob plentyn.

About the pilot

A pilot service is being offered the summer school holidays to enable children of full-time school age with emerging or identified Additional Learning Needs (ALN) to attend childcare. Enabling parent/carers to work, attend education or participate in training.

The grant helps the club employ an additional Playworker to support the child.

Eligibility

The grant is for children and young people of full-time primary education age who need one-to-one support to attend Holiday Childcare Club.

Priority may be given where childcare supports parents/carers to work, return to work or training, receive respite, or enables the child to access play opportunities.

Support needs may include specific, physical, emotional, social, behavioural, learning, sensory, speech, language or communication needs, English as an additional language, or another identified need.

Who can apply

Applications are made by the Holiday Childcare Club.

A referral to the provision can be made by a school, parent/carer, partner organisation or professional who knows the child and is supporting the family. A separate application is needed for each child.

Beth all y grant ei dalu?

Gall y grant gyfrannu hyd at £13.45 yr awr tuag at gyflog y Gweithiwr Chwarae un-i-un, hyd at 9 awr y dydd ac uchafswm o 25 awr yr wythnos.

Rhaid i staff a ariennir drwy'r grant feddu ar wiriad DBS boddhaol cyfredol ac ni ddylid eu cynnwys yng nghymarebau staff.

Telir y grant yn uniongyrchol i'r clwb gofal plant. Rhaid i'r rhiant, gofalwr neu'r clwb dalu unrhyw gostau ychwanegol.

Pryd dylid cyflwyno ceisiadau?

Rhaid derbyn ceisiadau o leiaf 5 diwrnod gwaith cyn y dyddiad cyntaf y mae angen y cymorth.

Mae cyllid yn gyfyngedig a bydd ceisiadau'n cael eu hystyried ar sail dreigl hyd nes y bydd y cyllid sydd ar gael wedi'i ddyrannu. Nid yw cyflwyno cais yn gwarantu cyllid.

Beth sy'n digwydd nesaf?

Bydd ceisiadau'n cael eu hadolygu a bydd ymgeiswyr llwyddiannus yn derbyn llythyr dyfarnu ysgrifenedig.

Ni ddylai clybiau gyflogi Gweithiwr Help Llaw cyn derbyn y llythyr dyfarnu oni bai eu bod yn derbyn cyfrifoldeb am unrhyw gostau os bydd y cais yn aflwyddiannus neu cyn dyddiad dechrau'r grant a gytunwyd.

What does the grant cover?

The grant contributes £13.45 per hour towards the one-to-one Playworker's wage, up to 9 hours per day and a maximum of 25 hours per week.

Staff funded through the grant must have a current satisfactory DBS check and must not be included in the staff ratios.

The grant is paid directly to the childcare club. Any additional costs must be met by the parent, carer or club.

When should applications be submitted?

Applications must be received at least 5 working days before the first date support is needed.

Funding is limited and applications will be considered on a rolling basis until the available funding has been allocated. Submitting an application does not guarantee funding.

What happens next?

Applications will be reviewed and successful applicants will receive a written award letter within 5 days of application submission.

Clubs should not employ an Extra Hands Worker before receiving the award letter unless they accept responsibility for any costs if the application is unsuccessful or before the agreed grant start date.
